

# FAQs for the 2022 MOC Fall Rally

## When is the 2022 MOC Fall Rally taking place?

- This year's Rally will be an 8-day Rally beginning on Friday, 9/9 and concluding on Friday 9/16, with departure on Sat, 9/17.
- There are two optional early arrival days available, Wednesday, 9/7 and Thursday 9/8.

## What are the prices to attend the 2022 MOC Fall Rally?

- Pricing to attend the Rally and optional early arrival days is as follows.
- Rally and camping fees, includes 1 Montana and up to two people.
  - 8 days, September 9<sup>th</sup> through September 16<sup>th</sup>, \$325
  - 9 days, September 8<sup>th</sup> through September 16<sup>th</sup>, \$355
  - 10 days, September 7<sup>th</sup> through September 16<sup>th</sup>, \$385
  - Each additional guest, \$50

## Where is the Rally held?

- The 2022 Rally will take place at the Elkhart County 4H Fairgrounds, 17746 County Road 34, Goshen, Indiana, 46528.

## Do all campsites have full hook up?

- All Camp sites have full hook ups, 50-amp, water & sewer. Most connections are located at the rear of the camp sites, bring extra hoses.
- Hose length? Sewer hose length needed is from the RV connector to the rear of your rig PLUS 10 feet. Fresh water, 50 feet.

## **When can we Register for this year's Rally?**

- The plan is to open Registration for this year's Rally in April, keep checking the forum for the announcement.

## **Do I need to make Rally reservations with the Fairgrounds?**

- No. By completing the online Rally Registration, your campsite reservation will be made automatically.

## **Can we stay at the campground beyond the last night of the Rally?**

- Anyone who is interested in extending their stay at the Fairgrounds following the rally, must contact the Fairgrounds office for arrangements.
- Elkhart County 4H Fairgrounds - (Phone: 574-533-3247).

## **What does the Registration Fee include?**

- Camp site with full hook ups.
- Rally bag filled with everything from discounts to T shirts.
- 8 days of training seminars and group activities.
- Several meals that are provided by Rally sponsors.
- Saturday Night Social with live entertainment.
  - These are just a small sampling of what is included.

## **Will I need extra cash?**

- YES, the MOC Rally cannot take credit cards or checks as payment for extra activities requiring payment at the MOC rally.
- Here are a few of the optional activities that are not covered by your registration fee.
  - Amish meal, RV wash & polish, Crafts classes & supplies.
  - Raffles, silent auction, garage sale, pancake breakfast.
  - There are also vendors who may prefer cash.

### **Will there be Vendors at the rally that will have items for sale?**

- Yes, both original equipment and aftermarket.
- The vendors are only available to visit during a limited number of days. (Check Rally schedule once available)

### **Can I get items repaired on my Montana during the rally?**

- Yes, you must sign up to have repairs scheduled for your rig.
  - Watch for “sign up” on the MOC Forum
- Considerations are made for all repairs requested for units that are under warranty as well as out of warranty.
- Keystone provides factory trained technicians to perform limited repairs to your rig.
- Repairs are limited to two, fifteen-minute items that can be repaired at your campsite.
- All repairs to be completed in the order that they are scheduled by Keystone. You must be present at your rig at the time of repair.
- Keystone will attempt to contact you via your cell phone prior to arriving to complete the repairs.
- All repairs are totally at the discretion of the Keystone Customer Service representatives.
- There are a limited number of days to complete all requested repairs; it is important that Keystone representatives can adhere to the schedule.

### **Will there be time during the 8-day Rally to explore the local area?**

- Yes, with the addition of the 8<sup>th</sup> day, there will be ample time.
- If your schedule allows, arriving 1 or 2 days early allows even more time to visit the local area.

### **Can I request a specific campsite or request to camp near a friend?**

- No, campsites assignment is random and completed by the Wagon Masters.

### **Can I attend the rally without registering on the website?**

- No, only registered Montana 5<sup>th</sup> wheel owners who have paid the minimum fee of \$325 can attend.
- All attendees must display their MOC Rally credentials to attend all Rally activities.

### **Can I sell RV-related items while at the rally?**

- The rally offers Vendor booth rental for businesses.
- If you are not a business and have items for sale, you may display, and sell at your campsite at your own risk.
- Having a “Garage Sale” as a planned activity, is under consideration for 2022.

### **How many Montanas will be allowed at the rally?**

- There is a limit of two hundred registered units.
- Anyone attempting to register once the registration limit has been reached, will have the opportunity to be added to the “waiting list.” The “waiting list” is used to fill in cancelations as they occur.

### **Can I arrive prior to the first offered early arrival day?**

- No. The Fairgrounds does not offer any camping prior to the early arrival days. (2022, Sept 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>)
- There are other campgrounds available in the local area.

### **Is alcohol permitted at the Fairgrounds.**

- Yes, but we strongly encourage responsible consumption during the rally.

### **Are additional volunteers needed?**

- Yes, we are always in need of volunteers.
- There will be requests posted on the Forum to sign-up for specific duties.
- You can reach out to any of the Wagon Master Team members, before or during the rally. We are always looking for help.
- We encourage everyone to get involved, to ensure the success of our rally.
- Our Rally would not be possible without the tremendous support of our Volunteers.... we, thank you all!!

### **Is Wi-Fi available at the fairgrounds?**

- Yes, the Fairgrounds does provide complementary WIFI, however it can be slow at peak times.

## **What goes on during the Rally?**

- It is 8 days full of everything RV.
- There are round table discussions on varying topics.
- There are seminars given by original equipment and aftermarket vendors.
- Vendors will be set up at the Vendor Building with their items available for purchase.
- There will be Keystone Service Techs on site. (watch the forum for sign up and instructions)
- Shared experiences with fellow Montana owners.
- Great opportunities to meet new people and make life-long friends.
- Ample time to explore the local area, rich with traditions and history.
- Several meals are provided during the Rally, there are also many fine restaurants in the area.

## **Are handicap accessible campsites available?**

- Yes, there are a limited number available on a first come first served bases. Send your request via Private Message to the Wagon Master as soon as your registration is complete.

## **Are golf carts available to rent?**

- Yes, we do plan to offer rental golf carts.
- We are currently negotiating with golf cart rental companies, keep checking the Forum for updates.
- Your verification that you have adequate liability coverage with your insurance provider will be requested.
  - More related information will be posted on the Forum.

### **Can I bring my own golf cart?**

- Yes, personal golf carts will be permitted.
- Trailer and carts used to transport your golf cart, must be stored in the Fairground's designated area during the entire Rally.
- Your verification that you have adequate liability coverage with your insurance provider will be requested.
  - More related information will be posted on the Forum.

### **Can custom dietary restrictions be considered with sponsored meals?**

- No, unfortunately. The great number of varying restrictions make this impossible for our catering companies to prepare. Most Rally meals are geared toward large group meals and not custom individual meals.
- Most of the Rally meals are free to all attendees to enjoy and provided by the Rally's sponsors. There are also many local restaurants in the area for all to enjoy.

## **Any suggestions for first-time attendees?**

- On the first day of the rally there is a session available for all first timers that we encourage you to attend. The entire WM Team will be presenting points of interest as well as answering any questions.
- One of the best ways to meet new people is to volunteer.
- Be sure to be regularly checking the MOC forum for a variety of sign- ups, Volunteers needed, Tech Repairs, and Amish Dinner to name a few.
- Bring cash. Payment for purchases related to the MOC Rally, must be with cash only. Raffle tickets, 50/50 tickets, silent auction items, and the Amish dinner, just to mention a few. Also some vendors do take credit cards but not all do.
- During group functions, move around, grab a seat at a different table, this is a great way to make new friends. Join in at the camp fire, a great social event.

## **What do I need to know about the Ladies Driving School?**

- You must sign-up to get this training.
- The limited class size fills quickly.
- Keep checking the Forum for sign-up. Once you have signed up, keep checking the thread for updates and information.
- The school consist of two parts over 2 days: classroom and driving.
- Keystone provides Montana 5<sup>th</sup> wheels.
- The school needs six loaned trucks from attendees for the driving portion.
- We appreciate all who donate the use of their pickup trucks for this school. All donor-trucks must have adequate insurance coverage.
- Sorry, no men allowed to attend or watch.

## **When are Raffle Tickets sold and drawn?**

- Raffle tickets are typically sold and drawn whenever all attendees are assembled for Meet & Greet, meals, major sponsor presentations, and Saturday Night Social.
- You must be present to win. In the event that, you cannot be present for a drawing, I recommend that you ask a friend who will be present to watch your tickets for you.
- Just a reminder, raffle tickets can only be purchased with cash.
- Volunteers are needed to sell raffle tickets and help during the raffle prize drawings.

## **Can I request to be moved to another campsite?**

- No, all Rally campsites are assigned by the wagon masters.
- There are many safety reasons and activities that rely on accurate parking assignments. A couple of examples are, an emergency needing 911 at your camper, Keystone tech services planned dispatch.
- One of our greatest challenges at the rally is getting 200 Montanas parked as assigned. Our Site Escort Team has always done an outstanding job, site changing, would create unnecessary challenges to this monumental task.
- There are a few full hookup sites that are kept as spares for the 200 sites that we plan to occupy. These spares are used for the rare occasion that we must relocate individuals due to utility issues at their assigned campsite.
- There are a limited number of campsites at the Fairgrounds that have full hook ups with 50 amps service. Although there may be open camping sites, they most likely do not have full hook ups. These sites are not available for use by the MOC Rally.
